We invite you to join the North Carolina Blueberry Council and North Carolina State University for the primary educational meeting for blueberry growers in the state and region. The 58th Annual Open House and Trade Show will be held January 17-18, 2024 at the Charlie Rose Expo Center, Crown Complex, Fayetteville, North Carolina.

Our 2024 educational program is STRONG – including a research station update from John Garner, new results from testing of organic fungicides by Bill Cline, and a review of cultivar development at Castle Hayne by Jessica Spencer. We are also excited to have retired UGA horticulturist and consultant Gerard Krewer on the program this year, to talk about the use of ethephon in the Fall (for bloom delay the following Spring). We will also quiz Gerard about algal stem blotchthis disease is common further south, and is now appearing on some farms in NC. Mike Mainland will present data on the relationships between phenotype measurements (size, firmness) and keeping quality for each of the 82 cultivars he evaluated 2006-2019. Terry Bland will give a cultivar update, along with an overview of his recent trip to see blueberry production in Australia! Mark Seitz and Matthew Strickland will offer pesticide safety training (category V) for those who need credits to meet their certification requirements. In addition to the educational program, our new and returning vendors will be showcasing products to benefit your business during our Trade Show hours.
